(2) 【 Nobita is asking Shizuka to help him. 】

Nobita : I have something difficult to do today.

Can you help me after school?

Shizuka : Sorry, I can't.

Nobita : I see.

(3) 【 Betty gives a birthday present to Rose. 】

Happy Birthday

Betty : Happy birthday, Rose. Here is a present for you.

Rose : Wow. Thank you very much, Betty.

Betty : No problem. I hope you'll like it.

Rose : How cute! I've never seen such a beautiful doll.

Betty : I know you like collecting dolls.

Rose : Yes. I have about two hundred dolls. They are very cute.

Let's go to my room.

【 Rose is showing some dolls to Betty in her room. 】

Rose : Look. Here are my dolls.

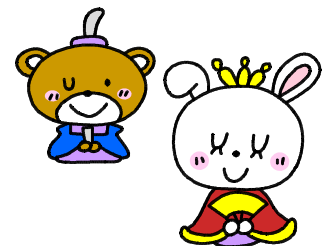
Betty : Oh, cute! Is this a Japanese doll?

Rose : No, it's a doll made in China.

My big brother bought it in China and gave it to me. He likes China.

これ以外の解答は先生に質問して確認しましょう!

【1】 (1) Shall I carry these books? / Shall I help you with carrying them? [ 申し出の表現 ]

Shall I help you with your homework? / I will carry them for you.

〈 タマの「本、重そうだね」のセリフに注目です〉

(2) I have to practice the violin. / I will study with Ms.Hanazawa.

I have a plan to make dinner.

[ 予定の表現 ]

〈 しずかの「ごめん、出来ない」の理由を補足します〉

(3) ① Can I open this box now? / Can I see it now?

[ 許可を求める表現 ]

〈 ベティの「いいわよ。気に入ると嬉しいな」のセリフに注目です〉

【「プレゼントを今見ていい?」と聞きたい状況ですね】

② I will show you my dolls.

【「人形を見せてあげるよ」と言いたい状況ですね】

③ Have you ever been to China? / Have you ever been there?

〈 ローズの「行ったことない。いつか行きたい」のセリフに注目です。〉

答えが No, I haven't. なので、質問は「完了形の経験の用法」だと予想しましょう〉
